



Important Registration  
Information for ESF in the HS

1. Enter data using proper **Upper and Lower Case Typing:**

Example: Jennifer Smith NOT jennifer smith  
4335 Elm Street NOT 4335 elm street

2. Name

- a. Enter your full LEGAL name (example: Michael NOT Mike)

3. School

- a. Choose the correct school from the pull down menu. This allows the classes offered at your school to appear.

4. Parent/Guardian Email address

- a. This is not required but it will be used if emails come back undeliverable (mailbox full, student changes an address and does not notify us).
- b. NOTE: Parent /Guardian email is preferred but an alternate personal email address can be inserted here instead.

5. Social Security Number (SSN):

- a. REQUIRED by the ESF Registrar
- b. If a you do NOT have an SSN (example: an exchange student), insert zeroes
- c. The school may be able to provide that information to the student.

6. Ethnic Origin

- a. We are limited to these choices. This is necessary for ESF Registrar, answer as honestly as possible.

7. County

- a. If you do not know this, ask someone to give you the accurate information.

8. Information Questions:

Question: Have you registered for another ESF course this or a previous year? Answer YES if you:

- a. took an ESF in the High School course last year
- b. took Introduction to Green Entrepreneurship at SUNY ESF for one week
- c. took an ESF Online or campus course

Question: Have you participated in the ESF/SCSD Environmental Challenge: 7<sup>th</sup> and 8<sup>th</sup> Grade Science Fair held at ESF? **This is for Syracuse City Schools.** Answer YES if you:

- a. Came to the ESF Library or the ESF alumni lounge to compete with other SCSD 7<sup>th</sup> and 8<sup>th</sup> graders in March with a science project.

Question: Have you participated in an ESF SCIENCE summer camp program? Answer YES if you attended:

- a. July or August thru La Liga, Syracuse Recreation, CNY Works, Nottingham Smart Scholars or Steward of Syracuse (Onondaga Lake)



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9. School Lunch Eligibility. Are you eligible for the free or reduced lunch program? If so select Eligible choice. This will be verified with your school district. If not, select Not Eligible.

9. Explorations in Urban Design (LSA296) 3 credits
10. Intro to Papermaking (PSE296)

COURSE PAYMENT:

When you get to the payment portion of your registration you can pay online using a credit card or by check. If you are unsure of how you are going to pay select check. Your registration will be completed and you will be contacted via email about your payment method. A payment plan is available.
